

New Parents...

If you choose Scottsdale Children's Group for your child's care, all you have to do is let the OB Admitting Department at either Scottsdale Healthcare-Shea or Osborn, know and they will notify our rounding Physician when your baby is born. The rounding Physician will see your baby in the hospital and they will inform you when to schedule your initial office visit with the pediatrician of your choice.

Please make sure that the OB Admitting department has your current address and insurance information. Upon registration let the hospital know what insurance will be covering the baby. If you do not have insurance, will you be applying for AHCCCS coverage? If so-we only accept-APIPA/AHCCCS.

Remember to add your baby to the insurance policy as soon as possible. This will ensure proper reimbursement for the baby's hospital costs. Your plan may allow 15-30 days to do this, but delays in processing could cause payments to be denied.
